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## Student Concern letters and Commendation Certificates

The issuing of the Term 1 – 3 Interim Reports will provide parents with an overview of their son's academic progress for each term (as well as our Semester 1 and 2 Academic reports). The College will also be undertaking the following steps to monitor and congratulate students based on their level of academic progress in Terms 1 and 3.

- Students of Concern - those students who receive an Overall D.S.E result of below 65% have been identified as a Student of Concern. Therefore, a Concern Warning letter will be sent home to those respective parents requiring them to contact their son's Pastoral Coordinator to set up a meeting where their son's academic application and progress for Term 2 and beyond will be discussed
- Students of Commendation – those students who receive an Overall D.S.E result above 85% will be acknowledged with a Commendation certificate for their positive academic application in Term 1 across all of their subjects. These students will be formally acknowledged and receive their certificates in Pastoral meetings.
