



ST DOMINIC'S COLLEGE REPRESENTATIVE CONTRACT

PURPOSE OF THIS CONTRACT

At St Dominic's College, we believe in the education of the whole person, nurturing not only academic and physical talents but also fostering personal growth through the lens of Catholic values.

Participation in College activities is an extension of this holistic approach to education, where students are given the opportunity to represent their College with pride and integrity. However, it is important to understand that this is a privilege, not a right.

By agreeing to represent the College, students must demonstrate dedication, respect, and responsibility both on and off the field. This contract outlines the standards and expectations that must be met to maintain this privilege, ensuring that all representatives embody the values and principles that are central to the St Dominic's College community.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

1. Diligence and Sustained Effort (DSE) Score

Students must obtain an average DSE score of over 75%.

2. Attendance at College Events

Attendance is required at all major College events, including but not limited to camps, reflection days, and college carnivals. Any absence must be justified and accompanied by formal documentation such as medical certificates.

Unjustified absences may result in students being ineligible for selection.

3. School Attendance

Students must be present at school on the day of their game to participate in representative sport.

Students must maintain an overall school attendance rate of 85% or higher, including late arrivals/early departures. Failure to meet this threshold without valid reasons and documentation may affect students' eligibility to participate.

4. Assessment Tasks and Classwork

All assessment tasks must be completed to a satisfactory standard. Failure to complete tasks will result in removal from the team until requirements are met.

It is the responsibility of the student to catch up on all work missed due to representative activities.

Students undertaking VET subjects: all work placement requirements must be met and up to date. If work placement and representative activities coincide, students are required to:

- advise the VET Coordinator
- gain written permission from their employer
- make up any work placement hours missed



5. Social Justice Hours

All mandatory social justice hours from the previous year must be up to date before students can participate in any College representative activities.

6. Training and Work Ethic

Full attendance at all scheduled training sessions is mandatory. Punctuality, commitment, and a positive work ethic are expected at every session. Any injuries, illness or pressing domestic necessities must be communicated with the coach.

7. Uniform and Grooming

Student's appearance must align with St Dominic's College Uniform and Grooming Policies at all times. Any student in breach of the College uniform and grooming policy will not be permitted to participate until the breach is rectified.

8. Respectful Behaviour

Students are required to display respectful behaviour towards all staff, students, and members of the school community. Any incidents of defiance, disrespect, bullying, or harassment will be taken seriously and may result in the immediate removal from the representative team.

Serious or repeated areas of Concern

If a student is placed on a PC Monitoring Card, his eligibility to represent the college for that week will be at the discretion of the Pastoral Coordinator.

Any suspension from school may result in an immediate suspension from participating in college representative activities. The duration of the suspension will be determined in consultation with the Pastoral team.

Students placed on Conditional Enrolment are ineligible for representative sport for the duration of the conditional enrolment period.
