



# NURTURING EXCELLENCE FROM YEAR 7 TO YEAR 12

**The Ignite Program at St Dominic's College is designed to identify and support academically capable and high-potential students from Year 7 through to the HSC. It provides a structured and enriched learning pathway that fosters deep thinking, academic challenge, and personal growth.**

## EARLY IDENTIFICATION AND PLACEMENT

Entry into the Ignite Program is based on performance in an external academic assessment completed during orientation, alongside previous school reports and other relevant data. This ensures a fair and comprehensive identification process. Placement is reviewed annually, taking into account each student's academic progress and DSE effort score.

## DEDICATED PROGRAM COORDINATION

A dedicated Ignite Coordinator oversees the program, working closely with students, teachers, and families to ensure each learner is supported and challenged. The coordinator monitors progress, facilitates access to extension opportunities, and helps students set and achieve academic goals.

## TAILORED CURRICULUM AND EXTENSION

Students in Ignite classes engage with the core curriculum in a more condensed and focused format, allowing time for enrichment activities and deeper exploration of concepts. Learning is designed to challenge students through higher-order thinking strategies and collaborative problem-solving.

## INDIVIDUALISED LEARNING AND MONITORING

Teachers use diagnostic data and ongoing assessment to personalise learning and monitor student progress. Parents receive a dedicated Ignite Report each semester, offering detailed feedback on their son's development and achievements.

## ACADEMIC ENRICHMENT AND CO-CURRICULAR OPPORTUNITIES

Ignite students are encouraged to participate in a wide range of academic competitions and enrichment programs, including those in STEM, Mathematics, Writing, and Ethics. These experiences build confidence, creativity, and critical thinking.

## TARGETED ASSESSMENT AND REPORTING

Students in the Ignite program undertake focused assessments that inform teaching and track individual growth. Parents and carers receive a dedicated Ignite Report at the end of each semester, providing insight into their son's progress and development.

## SPECIALISED LEARNING EXPERIENCES

Students benefit from targeted incursions and workshops in areas such as Robotics, Engineering, and Advanced Mathematics, designed to extend their learning beyond the classroom.
