## UNIFORM AND GROOMING

Students are required to wear their full Winter Uniform on return to Term 2. It is the expectation of all students attending St Dominic's College that they wear the College uniform with pride and follow the College guidelines regarding uniform and grooming (including haircuts).

Students and families are reminded of the following uniform and grooming requirements:

### SOCKS

- With shorts: plain black socks only (no logos, patterns, or symbols)
- With long pants: plain grey or black socks only (no athletic socks)
- Thursdays: St Dominic's College socks MUST be worn

### BLAZER AND TIE (TERMS 2 & 3)

- Blazer and tie are compulsory and must be worn to and from school and NOT hung on bags.

### HAIRCUTS

- Minimum number two
- Natural colour only
- Same length on back and sides
- Haircuts/colour done during holidays must meet standards on the first day back.
